



Levels of Excellence Awards Changes Goals

- Align with Strategic Plan (mission)
- Achieve appropriate balance and emphasis on
 - –Advocacy
 - Community Outreach
 - -Sustainability (Admin, Recruiting)
- Encourage more submissions
- Maximize impact of award (chapter effectiveness, motivation)
- Note: Awards ceremonies in even-numbered years
 - -Friday, October 28, 2022, Kansas City, MO

Levels of Excellence 2022-2023

- Changes promulgated in July
 - January-August activities only a positive
- 3 levels of awards: 3, 4 and 5 star
- Requires Council President input
- Visit reports will be considered
- Raised the bar for some criteria (e.g., CM useage)
- More emphasis on subjective grading than objective criteria
 - 75 Objective / 150 Subjective
 - Allows for greater variance in results
